Selective Entry Exam 2022

The exam dates for Selective Entry have been announced:

Year 9 entry: 23rd July, 2022

Year 10 & 11 entry: 8th June, 2022

The examination includes ability and achievement tests and takes approximately three hours to complete. The examination is designed to test and challenge students.

The examination comprises five tests, in the following order:

1. **Verbal reasoning** (multiple choice, 30 minutes)
2. **Numerical reasoning** (multiple choice, 30 minutes)
3. **Persuasive OR creative writing*** (writing task, 30 minutes plus 5 minutes planning time)

SHORT BREAK (approx. 20 minutes)

4. **Reading comprehension** (multiple choice, 30 minutes)
5. **Mathematics** (multiple choice, 30 minutes)

* Whether or not students are presented with a persuasive or creative writing task varies from year to year, with all students required to complete the same task in any given year.

Parental role in their child's studies:

Supporting your child in studies is a priceless investment.

Help develop organizing skills:

- Help your child in making a weekly (including weekdays and weekends) timetable to keep them organized. The timetable should have clearly marked times for studies, rest, play, food and other activities.
- Help your child develop academic goals.
- Help your child in keeping study material organized.
- Help your child develop attention to detail in studies.
- Help your child develop communication skills for class interactions with peers and teachers

Identify a suitable study space free from distractions:

- The area should be spacious enough to accommodate parent/s too.
- Remove any electronic device not needed during the studies.

Supervising and Associating with the child:

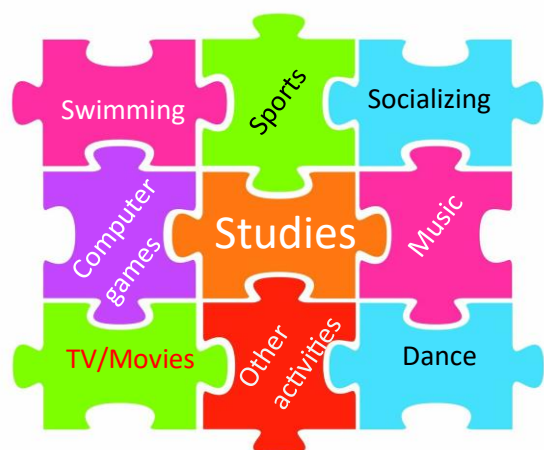
- Make it a practice to sit with the child as the child does the homework.
- Interpret homework/ assignment instructions, offer guidance.
- Divide homework into daily manageable parts.
- Check classwork and homework notebooks and worksheets.
- Verify assignment answers.
- Encourage the child to check/proof-read the work to eliminate any careless mistakes. If you can, check the work yourself to further minimize errors.
- Conduct regular/informal tests on spellings, word-meanings, times tables etc.

Follow a study-centric approach rather than activity-centric approach.

- Plan other activities keeping child's studies at the centre.
- Social commitments to be planned giving studies the much-needed priority.

The need to support will diminish as children grow up, become independent and start taking responsibility for their learning.
