Importance of good vocabulary

DEENA SEIFERT lists the following reasons for developing good vocabulary:

It Improves Reading Comprehension. Research has shown that kids need to understand 98% of the words they read to understand what they are reading. Improving vocabulary skills will improve their understanding of novels and textbooks.

It's Important to Language Development. Children who develop a rich vocabulary tend to be deeper thinkers, express themselves better and read more. Improving language and literacy skills early in life will help them be more successful academically and communicatively.

Communicating Ideas. Successful communication or “saying what you mean” is dependent upon a good vocabulary base. Using the right words when talking, makes you a more effective communicator.

Expressing Yourself in Writing. Having a good vocabulary to draw from can help you write more effectively. Students need to use a more formal tone when writing – not conversational language – and to do that, they need a richer vocabulary to tap into those words we don't use when we speak.

Occupational Success. Researcher Johnson O'Connor found that “a person's vocabulary level is the best single predictor of occupational success.” Success in the business place depends on your communication skills.

At Melbourne Tutorials, we continuously emphasise upon the importance of good vocabulary. Our curriculum places due importance on developing verbal reasoning skills for achieving high academic outcomes in schools as well as for success in various tests like Selective Entry, SEAL, Scholarship and other competitive exams.

Techniques to Improve Vocabulary:

- **Active Reading:** Regular reading of quality texts of different genres.
- **Maintaining a Wordbook:** Note down all challenging words that you come across words with their meanings, antonyms and sentence usage.
- **Focussed learning** of word roots, phrasal words, prefixes, suffixes, idioms, proverbs.
- **Revising** Synonyms and Antonyms:
- **Regular practice** and using strategies like **Flash cards, Look- Say- Write-Check** and **Word wall** in your study room.
- **Undertaking tests** on Verbal Reasoning components developed by experts.
